





The Law of Christ - love

Jesus said to his disciples: "I tell you, if your virtue goes no deeper than that of the Scribes and Pharisees you will never get into the kingdom of heaven." The Scribes and Pharisees in the time of Jesus were very good-living people who had missed the point. They were fully committed to the Law but had lost the Spirit. How easy that is for us to do also. In marriage, for example, it is not enough for a husband or wife to avoid getting involved in another relationship. Their fidelity is far more than that because it has to lead them to build up their love for one another in every way possible. Christ, our new beginning

"We do not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God." That's a difficult sentence for us to really listen to today in our consumer society. Jesus said: "Do not be afraid." In the Scriptures, fear is identified as the single greatest enemy of life and love. That statement "do not be afraid" is spoken 365 times in the Scriptures. The greatest fear that grips people is of what it is going to cost to really believe, to love, to enjoy. Fear of the cost can make us set limits to our love. And fear can make us set limits to our willingness to let God into our lives. As always, we need to think about this word of Christ in terms of the relationships of our lives and our faith. In every community very many people don't get involved in anything other than the minimum. This doesn't mean that these people are bad natured, but it is mostly because of this fear. Men particularly are afraid of developing the intimate relationships of marriage and family life for the same reason – they are afraid of the cost to themselves and they miss out on the rewards. The greatest commandment

"You must love the Lord your God with all your heart; you must love your neighbour as vourself." Jesus gives us these commandments as the only way to full human living and happiness. They are the core of Christian living and practice. We try everything else and yet love is all that human life is about here and hereafter. These two commandments go hand in hand as two parts of the one movement of life. Love of God is the ultimate in human life. It involves each of us in a personal relationship with God through prayer. Our Catholic tradition is very rich in the variety of prayer forms that are possible. Each of us needs to choose the ones that are helpful for ourselves. 




